An Important Update on Your Benefits Employee benefits cards moving to digital



March 2025

To make your benefits card more mobile and accessible, we are moving away from plastic benefit cards. Effective June 1, 2025, we will switch to digital benefits cards for your Canada Life benefits coverage, allowing you to have your card available on-the-go via your Smartphone or Mobile device.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR PLAN MEMBERS?

If you already have a plastic card, you can continue to use it as normal. However, if that card gets lost or stolen, it won't be replaced, and you'll use the digital card instead. All new plan members joining on or after June 1st will use digital cards.

If you don't already have a plastic benefits card, there are two ways to access your digital card:

- The My Canada Life at Work Mobile App (available via the Google Play Store or Apple App Store)


Note: From your wallet you can share cards with family members covered under your benefits plan.
