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## Retiree Advisory Committee Expression of Interest

There is a 10 member Retiree Advisory Committee which provides a mechanism for retiree members of the PSGIP to provide input for the consideration of the PSGIP Trustees as they perform their responsibilities to administer the Plan.

The Retiree Advisory Committee is a volunteer group which may determine their own process to act in this capacity. The PSGIP Trustees have a Retiree Advisory Committee Policy which outlines the expectations of this committee as summarized below:

- 1. To commit annually to continue to be a member of this committee;
- 2. To attend the December Trustee meeting for the Retiree Plan renewal presentation by the benefits service provider;
- 3. To attend the general meeting for Retirees in February;
- 4. Bring forward to Trustee any issues pertinent to the Retiree members;
- 5. Communicate information from Trustees back to Retiree members as appropriate.

Please note that ability to attend the December and February meeting is a mandatory criteria for serving on the Retiree Advisory Committee. The dates for these meetings are December 12, 2019 and February 27, 2020.

The Retiree Advisory Committee members shall be reimbursed for mileage and parking costs to attend these two above noted meeting.

There are currently two (2) vacancies in the Retiree Advisory Committee. The Trustees encourage representation on the Committee from diverse backgrounds and locations across the Province. Diversity may include but is not limited to gender, under 65 and over 65 members, health and civil service sectors, union and non-union representation. Currently there is not a member on the Committee representing the non-union retirees.
