DRUG COST ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (DCAP) AND BILL 13 – DRUG COST ASSISTANCE ACT

Changes to the Drug Cost Assistance Program came into effect July 1, 2014. These changes made the provincial drug programs second payer to the PSGIP retiree drug plan. The only provincial program the PSGIP retiree drug plan is not affected by is the Seniors Drug Cost Assistance Plan. For PSGIP retirees who are 65 years of age and over, the drugs covered by the provincial DCAP for seniors will continue to be submitted to the government plan.
